



# Notice of Review of Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations

In accordance with Section 17 of the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013, Cambridge City Council gives notice that a review of all polling districts, polling places and polling stations in the city of Cambridge is to be conducted.

1. The (Acting) Returning Officer will comment on the suitability of polling stations within each polling district. These will be available for viewing by request and on the council website in accordance with the timetable set out below.
2. Electors within the City of Cambridge are invited to make representations in connection with the review or comment on the (Acting) Returning Officer's proposals.
3. The authority welcomes the views of all residents, particularly disabled residents, or any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability on the proposals, the (Acting) Returning Officer's representation or any other related matters.
4. Persons or bodies making representations should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places or stations.
